Cover Letter

It is recommended to identify the petition purpose, the petitioner, and beneficiary at the top of all supplemental documents, such as the cover letter, history letter, letters of intent, even personal check. This in case documents get separated from the package, so that they can be reunited. And to avoid confusion, names presented as surname comma given names.

The table of contents on the cover letter, should provide a detailed listing of each document included in the application. There should be NO missing entries. For example

I note “Form I-129F Supplement: Part B, Question 18” listed on your cover. This refers to an obsolete version of the I-129F, copied directly from an out of date cover sample.

The TIMELINE and TIMING of evidences is important and provides valuable info to the reviewer. So telephone logs should not be simply labeled “Telephone Logs”, but [REDACTED]

Evidence Photos

Each photo should be carefully selected, there should only be a few well chosen ones, to convincingly tell your story.. Each should show different locations, times, clothing. This is NOT a photo album to be shared with your patient and supportive friends or family. It should be a short, clear, presentation to be made to a busy consular officer. He is ONLY interested in determining you spent enough time together, and did enough things together, to be convinced you are a bone fide couple, he is not interested in seeing multiple photos of your “day at the beach”.

Attached to your package you provided:

- 1 photo [REDACTED] useful
- 4 photos [REDACTED] beach. Use train + beach (max)
- 6 photos [REDACTED] use: announcement + 1 other (max)

MISSING: “personal” photos of you and her during [REDACTED]

Nor is the consular officer interested to read every single word you two exchanged. You should [REDACTED]
