[REDACTED] I find many minor problems that individually should not be an issue, but combined may cause delays in processing. I recommend you clean up as many as you can.

## **Binding**

**Binder:** You used a [REDACTED]  
[REDACTED] This adds weight, but not effectiveness. Typically USCIS will throw it away. Instead I recommend you just use [REDACTED] (see attached: Materials for Professional Looking Petitions)

**Index Tabs:** You used heavy divider sheets, [REDACTED]  
[REDACTED] Best to be consistent. [REDACTED] add to the weight but not the effectiveness of the petition. I suggest you lose [REDACTED] and instead use [REDACTED] (see attached: Materials for Professional Looking Petitions). That way there are no extra [REDACTED] extra work for USCIS to remove and discard.

I recommend you combine Exhibits 15 + 20, and identify the trips and dates each photo was taken from. At the bottom of each page of photos label the [REDACTED] you describe the Exhibit, say

Each photo should be carefully selected, there should only be a few well chosen ones, to convincingly tell your story.. Each should show [REDACTED] he is not interested in seeing multiple photos of your “day at the beach”.
